



## CLASSIC KAMCHATKA (TOUR #20) - 2020

### DE INTERÉS ESPECIAL

- **Volcán Tolbachik** – La erupción de 1975 cambió totalmente el paisaje de los alrededores, creando campos de lava y bosques calcinados.
- **Kozyrevsk:** Uno de los primeros asentamientos de Kamchatka, de gran valor histórico
- **The Bystraya River** – Descender el río en bote por un área prácticamente virgen
- **Volcán Mutnovsky** – Un impresionante volcán en activo que muestra fumarolas, pozos de barro hirviendo y otros impresionantes fenómenos volcánicos

Cruzando Kamchatka de sur a norte y cambiando de zonas climáticas, recorreremos la región central, donde encontraremos una de las áreas volcánicas más espectaculares de Eurasia: El grupo volcánico de Kluchevskaya, que incluye –entre otros- el volcán Tolbachinsky, que durante el pasado año 2013 estuvo en erupción y cuyos efectos nos trasladan a otro mundo: Nuevos conos volcánicos, campos de lava, cuevas donde el rojo del magma resplandece... sin olvidar el célebre bosque de árboles calcinados por la erupción del año 1975, que es una de las inolvidables imágenes que el visitante se lleva de Kamchatka

La ruta también incluye la aproximación (y el ascenso) a los volcanes Mutnovsky y Goreli, que se cuentan entre los más hermosos de la península

El itinerario recorre también al sitio histórico de Kozirevsk, el asentamiento original de los pioneros –cazadores y pescadores- en el río Kamchatka

Durante el descenso del río Bystraya tendremos la oportunidad de pescar y de tomar contacto con una naturaleza prácticamente virgen; tres días descendiendo el río en autonomía total y acampando en sus orillas

#### COMENTARIOS

Las salidas indican el día de inicio del tour, que comienza con el traslado del aeropuerto al hotel en Petropavlosk . No se tiene en cuenta el día de salida del país de origen, ya que al no estar incluido el vuelo cada viajero puede solicitar los arreglos que más le convengan (parada en Moscú, prolongación de la estancia en Kamchatka, etc.)

**En el precio de este viaje NO se incluyen los vuelos.**

#### ITINERARIO DÍA A DÍA

**Day 1:** Meeting in the airport, moving to Petropavlovsk-Kamchatsky (25 km). Accommodation in the hotel (DBL), rest, walking to the city. You will have the dinner with the guide at 20:00, discussion the program.

**Day 2:** Boat trip with fishing to the Avacha Bay (5-6 hours). Observing nesting places of sea birds, the island "Babushkin Kamen", the rocks "Three brothers". Moving to the Pacific ocean to the island "Starichkov". In the end moving to the volcano Mutnovsky on the vehicle (4WD) (100 km). Setting the camp. Night in tents.

**Day 3:** Ascent to the crater of the volcano Mutnovsky (2323 m). Observing active fumaroles, mud siphons, mountain lake. The Mutnovsky crater is the one of the most outstanding volcanic phenomenon in Kamchatka. The steep slopes surrounded the wide and deep cavity of the crater with gleaming glaciers, crushed cracks and lunges boiling fumaroles (ascent lasts for approximately 8 hours). Night in tents.

**Day 4:** Ascent to the volcano Gorely (1829 m), moving by lava flows and cinder fields, observing 3 craters with volcanic lakes (it lasts for approximately 6 hours). In the evening moving to the recreation center on the vehicle (4WD). Accommodation, rest, swimming in the pools with thermal water.

**Day 5: Optional.** On this day it is possible to go on a helicopter excursion to Geyser Valley and Uzon Caldera, Walking excursion round Geyser Valley. Lunch is at Geyser Valley. In the evening moving to the area of settlement Malka (130 km) on the vehicle (4WD). Setting the camp. Swimming in the hot springs. Night in tents.



**Day 6:** Moving to the area of Kluchevskaya volcanoes group on the vehicle (460 km). Lunch in the settlement Milkovo ([in café you pay yourself](#)). Moving to the foot of the beautiful volcano massif formed by the volcanoes Plosky and Ostry Tolbachik. By the road in a clear weather you will see the panorama to the volcanoes Krestovsky (4057 m), Ushkovsky (3903 m), Kluchevskaya Sopka (4750 m), Kamen (4579 m), Plosky Tolbachik (3082 m) and Ostry Tolbachik (3672 m). Night in tents.

**Day 7:** Observing the consequences of the 2013's eruption (the young cone, the wide fresh lava flows, caves – "lavovody", the stone sculptures and the heaps of hardened lava).

**Day 8:** Moving by car to the North breakthrough. Climbing to Tolbachik cones, which are volcanoes in miniature, their height of 100-200 meters. Moving to the South breakthrough (15 km.). Visit the Southern cone break, a walk in the "dead wood", crushed slag and ash eruptions in 1975. Return to camp. Overnight in tents

**Day 9:** Moving to the settlement Kozyrevsk, which is situated on the shore of the River Kamchatka (90 km, 3 hours). Accommodation in the private tourist shelter, in the wooden houses on the special equipped place. Classic Russian bath. Walking excursion on the one of oldest Kamchatka settlements, founded on the burg of Itelmens – aboriginals of Kamchatka in the 18-th century. Visiting the souvenir shop of local craftsmen. Visiting the viewing platform, which open the panorama on the whole settlement and river Kamchatka and volcanoes.

**Day 10:** Moving to the settlement Malka (130 km) on the vehicle (4WD) with the stop in the settlement Milkovo for lunch ([in café you pay yourself](#)) and for the excursion to the Ethnography Museum of the Kamchatka river's aborigenes. Starting rafting down the river Bystraya. Nights on the shore in tents.

**Day 11:** Rafting on the Bystraya River (passage of 2 rapids, there is high probability to see bears and salmon,). Fishing. Camping for the night.

**Day 12:** End of rafting with passage of the rapids. Driving back (180 km) to Petropavlovsk-Kamchatsky. Accommodation in hotel (DBL), rest.

**Day 13:** Transfer to fish market at 9:00. Transfer to airport.

**The sequence of the tour passage can be changed.**

#### **Optional excursions - Price**

In 2016 the cost of the helicopter excursion to the **Valley of Geysers** and the caldera of volcano "Uzon" was **39000 rubles**. The excursion is paid separately and on the day of excursion. The flight to the Valley of Geysers is realized only if the weather is nice and the group has enough people.



**The cost includes:**

- 3 times a meal on the whole tour except lunch in café Milkovo.
- Guide service on the whole tour
- Cook service on the whole tour
- Necessary equipment (tents, dishes, rafts etc. except sleeping bag)
- Transport service
- DBL accommodation in the hotel, in the recreation center

**The cost doesn't include:**

Lunches in Milkovo (250 – 300 rubles).

Additional excursions (for example, excursion to the Valley of Geysers)
